TOWNSHIP EASEMENTS ARE PURVIEW OF TOWN

Road easements along township roads are controlled and owned by the public. Baldwin Town Board would like to remind its citizens that installing sprinkler systems, gates, fences, impediments, headwalls, rock gardens, etc. are not protected and can be removed by the township.

Any infringement on the easement can be ordered to be removed either by the home owner, township maintenance, or Sherburne County. For the safety of our citizens and visitors, and the protections of township road maintenance equipment and its employees please restrain from any obstructions along, in, and by all township ditches. Easements can be measured from the center of your road toward your property are generally 33 feet (there are exceptions).

For more details about uses of township right-of-ways check with our supervisors, township clerk or Minnesota Statute 160.27 and particular uses of right-of-way Subd. 5. Please note any infraction of this law is a misdemeanor.


For his many hours and many meetings for over 27 years serving Baldwin Township, former Supervisor Jess Hall, was given
