

## BALDWIN TOWNSHIP WORKSHOP

May 18, 2011

**Present** – Supervisors Jay Swanson, Larry Handshoe, Tom Rush, and Randy Atwood.

**Call to Order** – The May 18, 2011 Baldwin Township workshop was called to order by Chairman Jay Swanson at 7:02 p.m.

**Pledge of Allegiance** – All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Elk Lake Beach Presentation** – Jon Bogart prepared two preliminary plans for erosion control at the Elk Lake beach area. The estimate for option 'a', plan 2 totals \$12,975.33; option 'b', plan 1 totals \$14,897.03.


Supervisor Kimberly Good arrived at 7:05 p.m.

Discussion was held on both plans presented. The town board preferred option "a" plan 2. Depending on the contractor bids grant money may cover \$9,750 with the township putting in the remainder of the funds. Basiletti said that SCSW possibly could add at least another \$700. There was discussion on what the Little Elk Lake Association could do to possibly cut down costs.


Swanson asked if encroachments would need to be moved; possibly removing the launch portion and make it entirely a beach area. Elk Lake has two other launches already. It would perhaps cost between \$1,000 and \$1,500 by taking out the boat ramp. Dean McDevitt, Little Elk Lake Association, said that the association is in favor of removing that landing. Blane Ding said the association would also be willing to do a lot of the work. Bogart commented that the biggest help would be the placing of the riprap. Swanson said he would like to use Option 'a'. Take out the boat ramp and entrance, and make a rain garden a little bigger. Bogart commented on taking out the boat ramp and keeping it class 5; then there would be room to park a couple of cars. Basiletti said it would be desirable to sign the plan since the money is already set aside. Since money will be drawn out of two groups; just a general concept plan and a rough estimate is needed.

Swanson said a formal motion to sign has not been made so suggested changing June 1<sup>st</sup> from a workshop to a special meeting. Added to the agenda for June 1<sup>st</sup> will be "Approve/Disapprove Contract for Cost Share with SCSW". Bogart agreed to come back to the meeting with a revised plan.
