

RESOLUTION #2002-04
ESTABLISHING BOUNDARIES OF ELECTION PRECINCTS

1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Baldwin as follows:

Precinct 1 Boundaries:

That area of the Town of Baldwin lying west of U.S. Highway 169 and outside of the boundaries of the City of Princeton.

Precinct 1 Polling Place:

Baldwin Town Hall located at 30239 – 128th Street in the Town of Baldwin.

Precinct 2 Boundaries:


That area of the Town of Baldwin lying east of U.S. Highway 169 and outside of the boundaries of the City of Princeton.

Precinct 2 Polling Place:

Baldwin Township Maintenance Building located at 30239 – 128th Street in the Town of Baldwin.

2. The precinct boundaries shall be effective for the conduct of the September 10, 2002 primary election. The Town Clerk/Treasurer is directed to post notice of the precinct boundaries in the office of the Town Clerk/Treasurer at least sixty (60) days prior to September 10, 2002.
3. The Town Clerk/Treasurer or County Auditor/Treasurer shall notify each affected household of the change in election precinct boundaries at least twenty-five (25) days prior to the first election in which the new precincts are used.
4. The Town Clerk/Treasurer is directed to immediately notify the Secretary of State of the change in precinct boundaries. The Town Clerk/Treasurer is further directed to prepare maps showing the correct boundaries of each election precinct in the Town and to provide a copy of the map to the Secretary of State within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution. A copy of the maps must also be available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk/Treasurer.
5. For each election held in the Town, the Town Clerk/Treasurer shall furnish copies of the appropriate precinct maps to the election judges for each polling place.
