**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF
ORDINANCE NO. 100; AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
TOWN ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAYS**

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2009, the Town Board of Baldwin Township adopted Ordinance No. 100 imposing regulations regarding its rights-of-ways, including regulations on utilities within its rights-of-ways (the "Ordinance");

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, section 368.01, subdivision 21 allows the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the whole ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance is approximately 22 pages long and publishing the entire Ordinance would be impractical;

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines publication of the entire Ordinance is impractical and that publication of its title and summary is sufficient to clearly inform the public its intent and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby decides to publish the following title and summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
TOWN ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY**

The Town Board adopted Ordinance No. 100 imposing regulations related to town road rights-of-way. The regulations apply to the entire width of the rights-of-way and include, but are not limited to, prohibitions related to cultivation, landscaping, obstructions, junk, alteration of grade, doing damage, electing to regulate its right-of-ways, require permits, impose fees, and place restrictions on those desiring to excavate or obstruct any portion of a right-of-way related to the placement, repair, relocating, or removal of utilities within town road right-of-ways. A copy of the whole ordinance is available for inspection at the Town's posting place, the Princeton Public Library, and a copy may be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk.

- Post a copy of the full Ordinance on the Town Hall bulletin board;
- Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Princeton Public Library;

- Within 20 days place a copy of the full Ordinance in the Town's Ordinance Book along with a copy of this Resolution and a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.
